### Long-time Custodian Ron Carlos Retires with Disabilities: Special Offering Being Received; Farewell Reception Sunday, February 26

After nearly 30-years, HUMC custodian Ron Carlos has been forced to take disability retirement due to significant heart, lung and circulatory problems (diabetes complications). Ron is immediately taking the short-term disability the church has provided as part of his salary package. Ron is also beginning the process of getting on Social Security disability. Upon recommendation of the Staff/Pastor-Parish Relations Committee (Julie Albert, chairperson) and concurrence of the Church Council (Duane Phlegar & John Weaver, co-chairpersons/lay leaders). Until that coverage begins, the church will continue to pay Ron's individual health insurance (but no longer than through December 31, 2012) and assist with the gap between his medical savings plan and the beginning of 100% insurance coverage (not to exceed \$3000.00).

Because of his long and faithful service, in addition to the assistance being extended, the Staff/Pastor-Parish Relations Committee and Church Council have also authorized and want to encourage the congregation in a special love cash love-offering. Checks may be made out to the church, designated Ron Carlos, and placed in the Sunday offering or sent to the church office. We would like to receive gifts prior to and no later than Wednesday, February 22. In addition, on Sunday, February 26, at noon, the

Staff/Pastor-Parish Relations Committee will host a "farewell reception" in the social hall, encouraging friends and church members to stop by to greet Ron and leave a "thank you note of appreciation."
