GOOD NEWS! Once again in 2007 our Permanent Endowment Fund produced sufficient earnings and appreciation to help fund the work and ministries of Hilliard United Methodist Church and Warehouse 839. During March various ministries, teams, leaders, task groups, and committees received applications for endowment funding. Eight applications were returned and the following grants have been approved:

MINISTRY TEAM	AMOUNT	PURPOSE
HUMC/Warehouse 839 Operating Fund	\$1,206.96	Fulfill the commitment of longtime member Jane Yost to continue supporting our work and ministries even after her lifetime.
Warehouse 839 Multi-Media Team	\$1,000.00	Replace and upgrade multi-media equipment for Warehouse 839 Building.
Sanctuary Building Multi-Media Team	\$1,000.00	Replace and upgrade multi-media equipment for Sanctuary.
Outreach Team	\$1,000.00*	Purchase books and materials and fund outreach ministries.
Habitat for Humanity Team	\$1,000.00**	Help fulfill the obligation of HUMC/Warehouse 839 for 2008.
Music Team	\$1,000.00	Christmas 2008 or Easter 2009 Cantata.

*Includes \$54.66 from the Bret Moran Fund designated to promote communication within the family.

**Includes \$611.22 from the Bob and Grace Snider Fund designated to assist people who are homeless, in financial crisis, or need help by missions at home or abroad.
